Looking Ahead: Rev. Mike Beck, a retired elder in the Indiana Conference, will be preaching for us next Sunday, June 25. Mike and his wife, Mickey, are no strangers to New Life. Both graduated from Triton Central High School ('67 and '69). Mike's family was attending New Life Church while he was serving as the Assistant Principal/Athletic Director at Triton Central when he felt the call to ministry. The congregation at New Life provided financial support to Mike's family which helped him to graduate from Asbury Seminary in 1985, for which he and Mickey will be forever grateful.

Rev. Mike served as Pastor of three larger congregations for 21 years before having to go on disability in 2006 due to developing four dystonias that affected his voice, eyes, right hand, and the muscles in his lower face. During his years on disability, he authored two books (one on effective ministry and the other on living with dystonia) as well as serving part-time for 3 years at Dearborn Hills and 3 years as Pastor at White Creek UMC near Columbus before retiring in 2017. With the help of his wife, Mike has preached in over 50 churches for pastors away on vacation since he retired.

Rev. Mike will be leading an 8-week class on "Growing in Our Faith" during the Sunday School hour starting July 9 at 9:30 am in the sanctuary. More information on this class will be in the July newsletter.
